List of US Student Visa Documents

1. Valid passport – Must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your intended stay in the U.S. and contain enough blank pages
2. DS-160 confirmation page – Printed confirmation of your completed online nonimmigrant visa application form
3. Visa application fee receipt – Proof that you have paid the required MRV visa fee before the interview
4. Photo – U.S. visa-compliant photo uploaded in DS-160 or printed if upload fails (must meet strict size/background rules)
5. Form I-20 (F or M visa) – Official Certificate of Eligibility issued by your SEVP-approved U.S. school after acceptance and SEVIS registration
6. SEVIS ID details – Information linked to your student record in the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (printed I-20 contains this)
7. SEVIS fee receipt (I-901) – Proof you paid the mandatory SEVIS registration fee before attending your interview
8. Interview appointment confirmation – Proof of your scheduled embassy/consulate interview date and location
9. Academic documents – Transcripts, certificates, and degrees showing your previous education history
10. Standardized test scores – SAT/ACT/GRE/GMAT or similar scores if required by your school
11. English proficiency proof – IELTS/TOEFL/Duolingo scores if required by your institution
12. Financial proof – Bank statements, sponsor letters, or funding documents showing you can pay tuition + living expenses
13. Sponsor documents (if applicable) – Proof of relationship and financial ability if someone else is funding your studies
14. Scholarship letter (if applicable) – Official award letter if your studies are funded by a scholarship

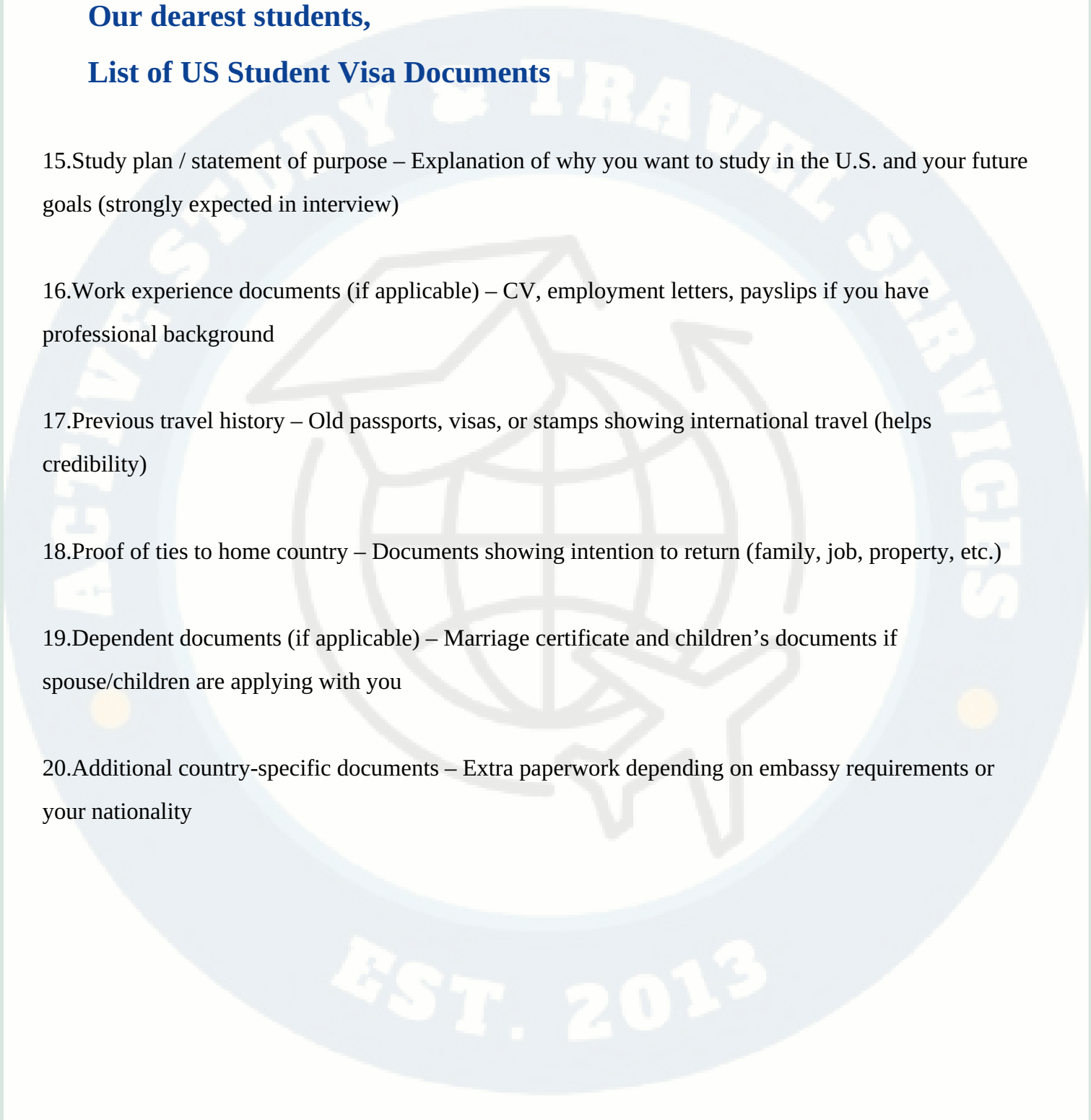

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15. Study plan / statement of purpose – Explanation of why you want to study in the U.S. and your future goals (strongly expected in interview)
 16. Work experience documents (if applicable) – CV, employment letters, payslips if you have professional background
 17. Previous travel history – Old passports, visas, or stamps showing international travel (helps credibility)
 18. Proof of ties to home country – Documents showing intention to return (family, job, property, etc.)
 19. Dependent documents (if applicable) – Marriage certificate and children's documents if spouse/children are applying with you
 20. Additional country-specific documents – Extra paperwork depending on embassy requirements or your nationality

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
